

Proclamation Albemarle Amateur Radio Club Field Day Exercises June 2015

Whereas, Amateur Radio Operators have provided countless hours of community services to our many Emergency Response organizations and to other local organizations; and

Whereas, these Amateur Radio services are provided wholly uncompensated; and

Whereas, these same individuals have further demonstrated their value in public assistance by providing free radio communications for local parades, bike-a-thons, walk-a-thons, fairs, and other charitable public events; and

Whereas, the Commonwealth of Virginia recognizes and appreciates the diligence of these "hams" who also serve as weather spotters in the Skywarn program of the US Government Weather Bureau; and

Whereas, the ARRL Amateur Radio Field Day exercise will take place on June 27-28, 2015 and is a 24 hour emergency preparedness exercise and demonstration of the Radio Amateurs' skills and readiness to provide self-supporting communications without further infrastructure being required;
