### **Estate report – Jim Owen:**

John Porter introduced Jack Smith for tonight's presentation.

Jack Smith, KE4LWT, is an emergency coordinator who runs central division in North Carolina will talk about Disaster Deployments. He has done many deployments around the U.S as a volunteer . He is Operations Branch Director. Works on National Incident Management System (NIMS).

### **Challenges:**

- Austere environment
- Unfamiliar organizational structures
- Evolving or devolving communications systems
- Safety and security

#### Pre-deployment:

- Family situations
- Self evaluation (personal safety)
- Training: capable and confident, train with experienced operators
- Readiness: physically, mentally able to withstand rough situation, practice in field
- Deployment kit: modular systems, checklist
- Notification

#### Deployment:

- Don't self-deploy, report into deployment manager or director of organization
- Capabilities: may need to redeploy frequently and rapidly
- Self-care: take care of self, normal operating period 12 hours
- Relief: reassignment as situation evolves
- Additional notes: track what you use, refine what to bring in future deployments

#### Post-deployment:

- Fill out activity log and ICS309 comm's log and after-action document. Request feedback.
- Self-assessment: what works, what practice do you need
- Self-care
- Reset: repair, replace, refine packing list

#### Observation from Deployment:

- Infrastructure overload: not enough excess capacity
- Infrastructure outages: large disasters may cause running out of fuel, power, etc.
- Remote operations: ham radio is bridge
- Situational awareness: roads, weather conditions
- Insufficient utilization: don't want to be sitting around, use other skills to help out if you have time
- Emergency communications: provide comm's to save lives and property. All other comm's not emergency.
- Usually first 24 hours of emergency no health and welfare messages allowed.
- Used WinLink to send resource requests and other low priority traffic late at night when traffic is low.

#### Q & A followed:

72 hours need to be self-sufficient is usual rule of thumb.

Most emergency comm's uses VHF 2 m. He uses J-Pole antenna and sound card, solar panel, batteries for 72 hrs.

#### **Other business:**

Ed will send email to save date for picnic.
