AARC Meeting Minutes July 13, 2021

In the absence of Steve Kramer KN4CJI, Secretary, Larry Eicher, K4JZQ took minutes for this meeting.

President Ed Berkowitz, N3US, called the meeting to order at 7PM via Zoom. A total of 29 participated in the meeting. Names are listed at the end.

Committee Reports:

Technical – In absence of Gordon Winn, Ed Berkowitz N3US reported for Gordon that two weeks ago Yaseau repaired and was about to ship our 2 meter fusion repeater. Gordon hoped to get the tracking number shortly. Since one of our antennas is defective, he will wait until we transition to the new County tower before we put this Repeater back in service. It is not cost-effective to pay a tower climber to install a replacement antenna on the old tower. Ed suggested that Gordon convene the Technical Committee on next steps.

Introduction and Vote on New Members -

Ed N3US moved to conduct the approval vote of new members, based on current bylaws, but indicated a future revision of the bylaws might omit the need to have members formally vote new members into the club.

Discussion: Dave Damon K4DND suggested that the club keep the vote requirement by the general membership but assign older members as Elmers to each new member. This will be discussed in the future.

Ben Lechlitner, KC9INE, Stephen Esposite AE4SJ, and Sara Townsley all gave brief background comments.

Michael Rein KA4JJD called for the vote to be taken; seconded by John Porter KK4JP, Vice President. Vote was unanimous and Ed, N3US welcomed these new members to the club.

Ed, N3US reminded members that we have been holding monthly meetings for over a year via Zoom due to the Covid pandemic and NRAO not permitting in-person meetings at their facility. Currently as conditions seem to be getting easier, Ed N3US and Don N4UVA have been searching for a possible alternative location for in-person meetings but first they want to check with the pulse of the membership and whether there is a consensus on this issue. We still have a paid-up membership in Zoom from April 2021 through April 2022 at \$10 per month. Ed advised that Steve Kramer KN4CJI had found a location close to Wegmans near the south of the city as a possible location for a future in-person meeting. The rental for the room would be \$60 for two hours, with the usual privileges and limitations such rental rooms cover.

Comments from members were almost unanimous in favor of keeping with Zoom vs. an in-person meeting. Some asked whether we could integrate an in-person meeting with Zoom for those members unable to attend in person. John Porter KK4JP indicated that would require a good internet connection which is not necessarily possible at some rental locations. Ben KC9INE indicated that Zoom can be recorded for others who don't attend a meeting can still watch it later; Ed commented that we also recorded and posted our in person meetings. Ben KC4EIF has young children so for him the Zoom option is best, Frank W4NUA prefers Zoom due to distance that he would have to travel, Steve KA4FOX said Zoom meetings allow him to multi-task during the meeting, and Dave K4DND also indicated he likes Zoom.

While no one spoke in favor of in-person meetings, Ed N3US did indicate we have a picnic scheduled in October and our Annual Awards Dinner in December so there would be some in-person contact as well as a resumption of our Panera Bread Barracks Road breakfasts every other Saturday beginning in July. Michael KF4BFB suggested that we alternate between in-person meetings vs Zoom meetings. Ed N3US agreed to continue this conversation and asked members to send him other ideas and/or possible suggestions.

Ed N3US then asked Michael KA4JJD to discuss the need to activate the AARC Facebook page and have it become more prominent. Bob K4DU and Michael KA4JJD would welcome more members to a Facebook committee to come up with ideas on how to achieve this.
