Treasurer's Report - Larry Eicher:

As of March 1st, balance is \$38,745.37. Good turnout for renewals and received money from estate sales thanks to Jim Owen and Ed Berkowitz. Reminder to pay 2023 dues by April 1st. Technical committee - Bill Pond:

Last month club approved funds to purchase antennas for Bucks Elbow repeater. Bill said Tessco raised prices per antenna \$200. Shipping costs are \$383. Amount approved last month was \$3930. We now need \$4523, an increase of nearly \$600. He requested the club approve additional funds for purchase of antennas. Joe P. made motion and Dave D. seconded it. Motion carried unanimously.

Bob said we need labor quote to install antennas. Getting them installed is moving at a slow pace due to huge backlog.

Mike McPherson suggested finding young person willing to do antenna installations and club pays to send them to training course. One week tower school costs about \$1000.
